DAVID DELBRIDGE RELEASES DEBUT SINGLE, “HEAT DEATH”

Distributed in Dolby Atmos, the Dark Ambient Instrumental Takes Listeners on an Immersive Journey to ‘The End of the Universe.’

INCLINE VILLAGE, Nev., Dec. 31, 2021 – Electronic rock musician, David Delbridge, proudly announces the release of his debut single, “Heat Death.” At nearly five minutes, the sprawling track features a Yamaha C7 grand piano delicately navigating through an angry ocean of distorted synthesizers – a variance of instruments that touches multiple genres: dark ambient, electronic rock, avant-rock and post-progressive.

“Heat Death” represents five years of labor. In 2016, Delbridge retired his Internet hosting company to pursue music full-time, fulfilling a lifelong dream. In the years that followed, he studied music business and technology at the Berklee College of Music, designed and built a state-of-the-art recording studio in his home, and finally, spent two years developing his sound and repertoire.

“I’m extremely pleased with this release,” comments David Delbridge. “It embodies a lot of accomplishments – not only in music craft, but in music business and tech. I enjoy the challenge, but it’s a lot of
